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Introduction

The territory of the National Park “Bjeshkët e Nemuna” has natural values of extraordinary importance for the Republic of Kosovo. It is distinguished by areas of special natural value, hydrography, forests, pastures, meadows and biodiversity. Within about 63 ha (hectares) of the territory of the National Park “Bjeshkët e Nemuna” there are localities of special importance in terms of natural values, some of which are strict plant and animal reserves that fall into the first category of protected areas of nature according to the IUCN.

Many of the plant and animal species are also in the Red Book of Flora and Fauna of the Republic of Kosovo. Despite the Law on Nature Protection and other relevant laws in force, and the fact that this Park is in the second category of nature protected areas according to IUCN (National Park) and is protected by law, in this Park are unfortunately evident activities which are prohibited to be exercised within the park according to the relevant laws in force, or even activities which are exercised in an uncontrolled manner or which are not properly managed.

Among these negative phenomena are: waste dumping, erosion of areas for the construction of illegal tourist and hotel facilities, illegal hunting, uncontrolled collection of medicinal and aromatic plants, illegal construction, illegal logging. All these phenomena have extremely negative consequences on the degradation of the environment and on the future sustainable development of the Park.

Continuation of uncontrolled deforestation would have irreparable consequences that in addition to the loss of timber, directly reflects on the disruption of ecosystems, the threat of wildlife, landscape degradation, the occurrence of erosion, etc. Constructions that have not been done based on spatial and regulatory plans, which are mainly represented by hotel and residential facilities, are more pronounced in the most visited areas such as: Rugova Gorge, Boge, Leqinat, etc. If this phenomenon continues in the current trend, it will of course degrade the national park space, because people would build where they should not, which would damage the landscape, vegetation and animal habitats. Although there is no major pollution in the park, this has started to happen nonetheless. Here we do not have industrial development and dense transport, as the cause of the most negative impact on the environment, therefore air quality is good, but soil pollution from waste disposal and water pollution is unfortunately evident in areas with potential for tourism development. .

Project Objectives

- Improving the implementation of the Regulation on the Internal Order of National Parks and the punitive provisions of the Law on Nature Protection related to prohibited and degrading activities for protected areas.
- Better cooperation between the institutions responsible for the implementation of the legislation in force for the protection of the National Park "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" and the resident citizens of the Park, but also those who are visitors.
- Raising awareness of citizens about the natural values of the National Park "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" as a protected area.

Legal Aspect

From the legal aspect we based the implementation of this project on the following documents:

- Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan
- Law on Nature Protection
- Law on the "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" National Park
- MESP REGULATION No. 21/2013 ON THE INTERNAL ORDER OF NATIONAL PARKS
- Municipal Regulations for Protected Areas

In the framework of the Law on Environmental Protection, the sub-legal act "Regulation on the Internal Order of National Parks" is in force, which determines the protection, preservation, promotion and use of National Parks and determines the measures for non-compliance with its provisions. Also, the punitive provisions within the Law on Nature Protection provide for fines for those who degrade the environment within the Park space through certain actions. The effective implementation of these laws and bylaws would greatly contribute to the protection of the environment and the natural values of the Park. In terms of protection, preservation and development of a rich natural heritage, it is also necessary to increase the awareness of residents and / or visitors of the Park.

In "Bjeshkët e Nemuna", specifically in the Allaga River, Koshutan, above the village of Boge and at the hydropower plant in Deçan lives the Balkan Lynx (lat. *Lynx lynx balcanicus*), which according to IUCN (International Union for Conservation of Nature) carries the status of Extremely Dangerous "(Critically endangered)" because the population of this species is declining throughout the distribution area.

The main threats to the Balkan lynx are the small population, the limited

host base for it, habitat degradation and poaching. Deforestation, too, is a risk factor for the population of this species.

"Bjeshkët e Nemuna" are characterized by extraordinary floristic diversity and represent one of the floristic centers of the Balkans, especially in terms of floristic endemism. Their vascular flora in the part of Kosovo consists of 1,611 taxa (species and subspecies): 435 genera, 105 families, 50 orders and 6 classes. (1)

Intentional arson in "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" and its aftermath

Over the past few weeks we have witnessed the tragic news of mass fires around the world. Unfortunately, "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" National Park in Kosovo is also

This alarming situation reminds us of the botanical, faunal, ecological, tourist, recreational, sports, cultural and economic values that these Mountains have.

Bjeshkët e Nemuna is a hotbed of biological diversity and historical and tourist values in Kosovo. The fires in Shtupeq of "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" have left behind large parts of the mountains completely destroyed. There were only a few small fires on Friday. In addition to firefighters, police officers, members of the Kosovo Security Force, soldiers of the NATO mission who dumped water by helicopter, as well as local residents were engaged in extinguishing the fires in this location.

Deliberate arson is causing extraordinary consequences in the biodiversity of the "Bjeshkët e Nemuna", so Let's Do It requires citizens to be much more careful with their actions as well as institutions to be more attentive in field monitoring.

Hydrology of "Bjeshkët e Nemuna"

One of the main values of "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" is their hydric wealth. In "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" there is a dense network of watercourses that discharge water into the Drini i Bardhë and through it into the Adriatic Sea catchment.


In addition to the Drini i Bardhë Spring, most of the "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" are drained by its right tributaries: Shushica, Lumëbardhi i Pejës, Lumëbardhi i Deçanit, and Ereniku. On the left side of the Drini i Bardhë, the waters from the eastern part

of "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" are drained by the river Istog. All these streams flow into Drini i Bardhë and through it into the Adriatic Sea. Lumëbardhi i Pejës is the right branch of Drini i Bardhë and has a total surface of the river basin of 503.3 km², while in Bjeshkët e Nemuna 264 km², or 52.4%. The upper flow of Lumëbardhi of Peja to the city of Peja as a whole has the character of a mountain flow and covers more than half of the surface of the Cursed Mountains.

It should be noted a number of very beautiful lakes located in the proposed area National Park. An interaction of water and karst substrate of "Bjeshkët e Nemuna", has made the area characterized by a large number of caves and canals. Thus, in recent years it has been explored by Czech speleologists in collaboration with local caves called the Great Cave. (3)

Strict nature reserves in the National Park "Bjeshkët e Nemuna":

1. Bjeshka e Kuzhnjerit / Maja e Ropsit - area 1,110. 57, (2016).

Plant reserves of the species Molika, Fir, Pine, Beech, and Wild Goat (*Rupicapra rupicapra* L.).

2. Prilep Mountains - area 106.04 (2016). Pure plant reserves of mountain maple (*Acer heildreichii*) and Arnen (*Pinus peuce*).

3. Gubavci - area 76.86, (2016). Endemo-relict shaft plant reserves (*Forsythia europaea*).

These reserves as well as other strict reserves should be in special focus of the respective institutions. (4)

Turism in “Bjeshkët e Nemuna”

“Bjeshkët e Nemuna” are known for their rich cultural traditions. Natural beauties and rarities, characteristic clothing, customs and traditions, Rugova dance, etc. are rare cultural values, attractive to any visitor.



Numerous caves have high tourist and study values, such as the Cave of Radavc, Karamakaz, the small princess caves, the caves along Gërle e Koshutanit, the cave near Gurra e Rutës, etc.,

which in the future may also be centers of study by speleologists.

When we talk about mountaineering, we find expressions and opportunities for excellent development in the rocky massif, in the second region of “Bjeshkët e Nemuna”, as the peak of Gjeravica 1656m going towards the border in Boriq 2330m and in the rocky peaks in the north of Albania as Maja e Hekurave, Shkelzeni. The resource territory of Drini i Bardhë also offers very suitable conditions, then the territory of the lakes of Leqinat and some other terrains where the capacities for summer rest and treatment can be developed.

According to the data in “Bjeshkët e Nemuna” there are about 31,500 m and can withstand up to 30,000 skiers. The main terrains for skiing are; Kopranik, Rusolia Peak, Liqenat Mountains and Mokna Mountains. The areas in the territory of Boga, Kuqishta, Bjeshkët e Lumbardhit, Mokna and some other terrains have very good preconditions for the development of tourism.

The attractiveness of the territory, especially of Rugova Gorge, historical cultural monuments, other natural values, has a significant impact on the motivation of weekend tourism. The rich cultural-ethnographic heritage, settlements and villages in the areas of Rugova (handicrafts, folklore of Rugova) are also a great motive for coming to this National Park. (5) (6)

MONITORING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REGULATION

During the period March - December 2020, fines and criminal reports filed by the Directorate of Administration of the National Park "Bjeshkët e Nemuna" against offenders are 32 denunciations for illegal logging and 118 criminal reports for illegal construction.







During the roundtable the actors discussed about the role of institutions and the community in preserving the protected area National Park "Bjeshkët e Nemuna", the condition of this park and the possibilities of conservation and sustainable use in the future.

Invited to the roundtable were all relevant actors including representatives from the Ministry of Environment, Spatial Planning and Infrastructure, the Environmental Protection Agency in Kosovo, the Institute for Nature Protection, the Directorate of the National Park "Bjeshkët e Nemuna", Municipality of Peja, Civil society and community representatives.

Recommendations

The debate that took place was constructive and quite fruitful. Some of the recommendations that were drawn from this meeting are:

1. Give the deadline for the approval of the Spatial Plan.
2. The final draft of the Spatial Plan should be accessible to all.
3. More advanced institutional coordination.
4. Respect for the rights of the community for the use or compensation by the state of their assets.
5. Take responsibility from the competent institutions to extend waste management within the Park area, expansion of mobile teams, co-participation by the Ministry and Municipalities.
6. Facilitate the process of legalization of private buildings.
7. To pass the final draft of the Spatial Plan where the community was also part during the discussion.
8. To review constructions without permits and without criteria on both private and public lands.
